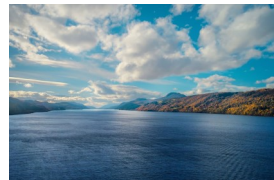

The four seasons are Spring, Summer, Autumn and Winter.



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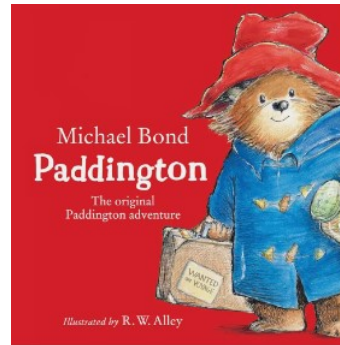

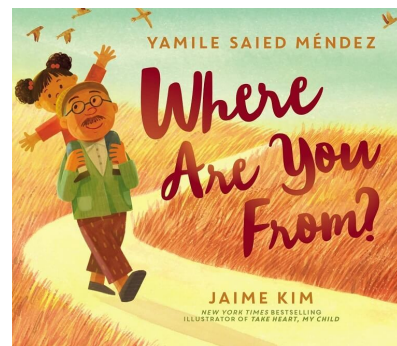
- Many fruits and vegetables are grown by farmers, but some fruits are grown in hot countries.
- Healthy foods provide the body with **vitamins** and **minerals** which help it to **function**.
- Unhealthy foods are high in **sugar**, **fats** or **carbohydrates**.
- To cut food safely, fingers should not be in the way of the knife blade and the surface should be flat.
- Hands, surfaces and **utensils** should be clean.
- Cold dishes have typically not needed any cooking e.g., a salad
- Some foods are made in factories from other **ingredients** such as potatoes make crisps, cocoa beans make chocolate, flour makes bread.
- A hot dish is something which has been cooked or heated and is eaten while still hot
