Subject Specific Vocabulary	
Earth	The world is a planet - our planet is called Earth.
Country	There are 195 countries in the world. There are lots of differences between countries.
United Kingdom	The United Kingdom is made up of 4 countries: England, Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland. It is also known as Great Britain.
Town	A town is an area where people live, it is larger than a village, but smaller than a city.
Climate	The climate is a way to describe the typical weather in a country.
Cuisine	The type of food and drink that is eaten in a specific country.
Wildlife	Animals, insects, birds, plants and habitats that are in a particular area.
South Africa	A country located on the southern tip the continent of Africa. It has varied culture, landscape and wildlife.
Language	A way of communicating between people, either by spoken or written or signed words.
Culture	How people live including traditions, beliefs, food, clothing, music and celebrations.
Ocean	The salty water area that covers the Earth's surface, home to many plants and animals.
Land	The solid part of the Earth's surface where we live, grow plants, and build things. It includes mountains, valleys, forests, rivers, lakes and deserts.
