Art - How can nature inspire Art?

Subject Specific Vocabulary	
Art	Art is a way for people to express themselves creatively.
Artist	A person who does art or creative activities as a job or hobby.
techniques	Different ways to do something - a special way to do it, to achieve a specific result.
media	Variety of ways to create and produce artwork e.g. paint, sculpture, photography, dance, music
collage	Layering and sticking materials to make a picture or pattern.
photography	The art of creating and taking pictures using a camera.
sculpture	Using different materials to make a representation or structure e.g. clay, metal, stone or wood.
materials	Different items used to create art e.g. crayons, paper, paint, clay, fabric.
Nature / natural	Anything around us that isn't made by people - occurring naturally of the Earth.
animals	Living things that can move around and need to eat, breathe and sleep to stay alive.
plants	A living thing that grows on Earth - plants often have parts like stems, roots and leaves.
environment	The environment is everything around us: air, water, plants, animals, and even people - that helps us live and grow.

Key Knowledge - Art

Focusing on learning what an Artist is, as well as looking at different artworks and styles of artists. Learning techniques such as colour mixing, sketching and being able to make art inspired by nature.

There are beautiful and interesting things in our environment

Art is something we make to show our ideas and feelings

There are many different types of art and techniques - drawing, painting, sculpture, photography and collage

An artist is a person who creates art to share their ideas, as a job or hobby

Art can be made using different media and materials, including items from nature

Many artists use nature to inspire their work and we can learn about their pieces

Photography captures images and can be presented as art

Paint can be mixed to create new colours and white or black can be added to change the shade or tone

Collage is a technique using layering of materials to create a picture

Artists' work can be used to inspire our own creativity

Key Knowledge - Science

Focusing on our local environment and the nature within it - classifying animals and plants, life cycles, and being healthy.

Nature includes our landscape, plants and animals that roam the land and sea.

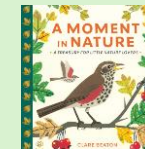
A lifecycle is a series of processes that living things go through, from birth to death.

All living things can be classified - sorted into groups.

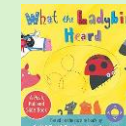

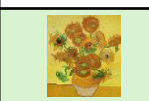
