community	A group of people that share things in common - usually the place they live, but can be other things, such as faith, hobbies and traditions.








Key Knowledge - History (Understanding the World)
The children will build upon their knowledge of the wider world and respecting how different people live their lives. They will learn about past events and the significant people who were involved in them. They will begin to understand what being significant means and why people from the past are remembered.

Key Knowledge - Expressive Art and Design
