Significant People	
Florence Nightingale	Florence Nightingale was a British nurse, statistician, and social reformer who was the founder of modern nursing. She was nicknamed "The Lady With the Lamp" for her work as a nurse during the Crimean War, where she improved the sanitation and care of wounded soldiers.
Captain Albert Ball	Albert Ball was a British fighter pilot from Nottingham during the First World War. He accrued many aerial victories, earning two Distinguished Service Orders and the Military Cross. He was the first ace to become a British national hero.
Robin Hood	Robin Hood is a legendary outlaw hero of English folklore. He is depicted as a skilled archer and swordsman who robs and kills the rich and powerful and gives to the poor.
